DIGGING DEEPER Read Acts 2: 42-47

The early Christian communities in Acts 2 meet regularly together to pray, worship and break bread, retelling and remembering the stories of Jesus together. As an expression of compassion and community they also shared their wealth with one another and especially shared with those in need. In the early Christian church we read about how worship, word and action all come together to shape a missional congregation.

- In what ways does this early Christian community live out a gospel of justice?
- Reading Acts 2 42-47 what are the marks or characteristics of a church community?
